SUBJECT:

Appoint Two Council Members to a Local Coastal Plan Update Ad Hoc Subcommittee.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Appoint two Council Members to a limited term ad hoc subcommittee to assist staff with the Local Coastal Land Use Plan Update.

STAFF CONTACT:

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BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

The City has received a grant to update the draft Local Coastal Plan (LCP) including sea level rise vulnerability assessment, risk assessment, and an adaptation plan. A Request for Proposals from qualified consultants to assist staff in preparation of these documents is currently available on the City website. Proposals are due July 24th.

The LCP Update and adaptation plan will study how sea level rise and erosion will impact social, economic, and physical coastal resources including: homes, businesses, recreation/open space, and critical facilities and infrastructure. The final documents will include strategies that will prepare the city to deal with these impacts.

Staff is requesting that Council designate two Council members to meet with staff on an as needed basis to assist in identifying issues and providing general guidance on this important City initiative. Because this ad hoc subcommittee consists of less than a quorum of the Council, is limited in scope and has a limited duration it is not considered to be a legislative body under the Brown Act.

RELATION TO CITY COUNCIL GOALS AND WORK PLAN:

The requested action assists in implementing Council Work Plan Priority 3:

Sea Level Rise - Participate with other agencies in regional planning activities; prepare

sea level rise policy by exploring "asset protection" and the role of sand replenishment and beach nourishment; include analysis of replacing Beach Blvd. sea wall vs. rerouting of existing infrastructure

FISCAL IMPACT:

No direct fiscal impact from appointing an ad hoc subcommittee. The LCP Update project budget including expenditures and grant revenues has been included in the adopted General Fund budget.
