




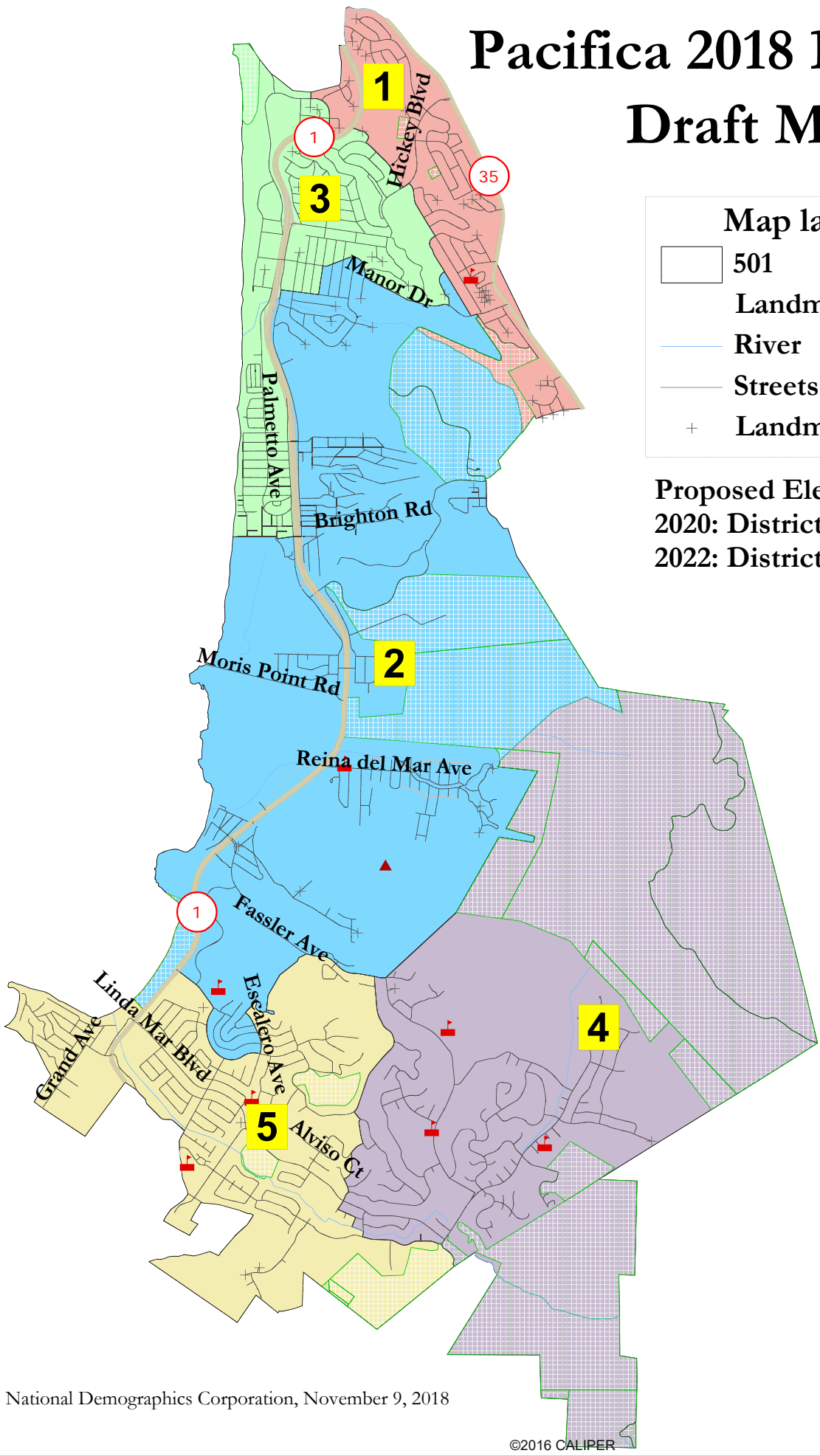


Pacifica 2018 Districting Draft Map 501
